Selection criteria for attending National & Triangular Tournaments: (amended May 2020)

The qualifying period is from the November game from the previous year up to and including the December game of the current year. The selection is done prior to the January game. These dates may vary depending on requirements.

Main criteria:

- 2 points are allocated for attendance at every "local" fixture.
 (A "local" fixture is considered to be a travelling distance of up to 49km from your home club).
- 3 points are allocated for attendance at every "away" game.
 (An "away" fixture is considered to be a travelling distance of 50km plus from your home club).
- Where a member participates in a non-WP Society game, whether in RSA or overseas he
 will be credited with 2 points applicable to every W.P. game so missed.
 (The onus is on the member to advise the secretary of such an occurrence).
- 3 points are allocated for entering the Triangular Tournament hosted by the Southern Cape Society.
- 4 points are allocated for entering any one of the previous two Nationals.

Selection will be based on the highest points tally.

Criteria in the event of ties

- In the case of a tie, attendance at the previous Triangular will be the determining criteria.
- In the case of a further tie the length of membership of the W.P. Society will be the determining criteria.
