Selection criteria for attending National & Triangular Tournaments: (amended May 2012)

The qualifying period is from the January game up to and including the November game. The selection is done prior to the December game. These dates may vary depending on requirements.

Main criteria

- 2 points are allocated for attendance at every “local” fixture.
(A “local” fixture includes the Alliance, Pinehurst and Championships).
- 3 points are allocated for attendance at every “away” game.
(These are the “arrange partner” games, excluding the Pinehurst).
- Where a member participates in a non-WP Society game, whether in RSA or overseas he will be credited with 3 points for every W.P. game so missed.
(The onus is on the member to advise the secretary of such an occurrence).
- 4 points are allocated for entering any **one** of the previous **two** Nationals.

Selection will be based on the highest points tally.

Criteria in the event of ties

- In the case of a tie, attendance at the previous Triangular will be the determining criteria.
- In the case of a further tie the length of membership of the W.P. Society will be the determining criteria.
